Scrapbook of Family Photographs, 1910-1920

Extent: 154 digital images on 2 DVDs.

Arrangement: Scans maintained in same order as they were fixed in original scrapbook.

Scope and Content

Scans of family photo scrapbook showing steamboat and other river scenes along the Missouri River. Subjects include: State Capitol construction (ca. 1915); group and individual snapshots and portraits; scenes on boat dock, on deck of boat, and on shore; family picnics; man playing music; a couple on a park bench; and many more. Individuals in the photos are unidentified.

Disk 1 contains 21 images of full pages from scrapbook; Disk 2 contains 132 scans of the individual photographs.
