

It is a class A misdemeanor punishable, notwithstanding the provisions of section 560.021, RSMo, to the contrary, for a term of imprisonment not to exceed one year in the county jail or a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars or both, for anyone to sign any initiative petition with any name other than his or her own, or knowingly to sign his or her name more than once for the same measure for the same election, or to sign a petition when such person knows he or she is not a registered voter.

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*Be in enacted by the people of the State of Missouri:*

*A new section of the Revised Missouri Statutes is hereby enacted, to be known as section 393.330 to read as follows:*

393.030. 1. The purpose of this section is to ensure that all retail and commercial customers of electric power in this state have the choice of electric suppliers, and to encourage competition in this state in the provision of electric supply.

2. No later than January 1, 2018, all retail and commercial customers of an electrical corporation as defined in § 386.020, RSMo., shall have the right to choose an alternative electric supplier. An "alternative electric supplier" means a person selling electric generation service to retail and commercial customers in this state.

3. The public service commission shall issue orders establishing a licensing procedure for all alternative electric suppliers. No alternative electric supplier shall engage in any business in this state unless it obtains and maintains a license issued by the public service commission.
