WHEREAS, on the 7th day of April, 1994, I issued Executive Order 94-15 establishing the Partnership on the Transition from School-to-Work.

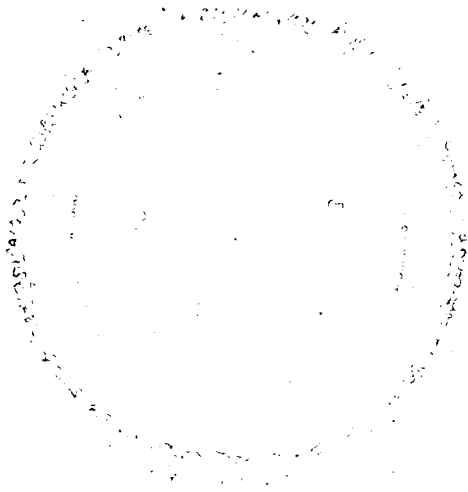
