

This section will contain the final text of the rules proposed by agencies. The order of rulemaking is required to contain a citation to the legal authority upon which the order of rulemaking is based; reference to the date and page or pages where the notice of proposed rulemaking was published in the *Missouri Register*; an explanation of any change between the text of the rule as contained in the notice of proposed rulemaking and the text of the rule as finally adopted, together with the reason for any such change; and the full text of any section or subsection of the rule as adopted which has been changed from that contained in the notice of proposed rulemaking. The effective date of the rule shall be not less than 30 days after the date of publication of the revision to the *Code of State Regulations*.

The agency is also required to make a brief summary of the general nature and extent of comments submitted in support of or opposition to the proposed rule and a concise summary of the testimony presented at the hearing, if any, held in connection with the rulemaking, together with a concise summary of the agency's findings with respect to the merits of any such testimony or comments which are opposed in whole or in part to the proposed rule. The 90-day period during which an agency shall file its order of rulemaking for publication in the *Missouri Register* begins either: 1) after the hearing on the proposed rulemaking is held; or 2) at the end of the time for submission of comments to the agency. During this period, the agency shall file with the secretary of state the order of rulemaking, either putting the proposed rule into effect, with or without further changes, or withdrawing the proposed rule.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: The Department received several comments in support of the proposed amendment.

COMMENT: Regarding 9 CSR 40-4.042 1(B) 7, 8, 9, 10, one comment was received proposing that individual, group and family counseling be added to the menu of services offered by community psychiatric rehabilitation (CPR) centers.

RESPONSE: This comment deserves further study and consideration. A workgroup is being formed to study and assess its impact on the current service delivery system. Future consideration will be given to adding these services to the existing CPR menu of services.

COMMENT: One comment was received regarding 9 CSR 40-4.042 1(B) 9. The commenter felt that adding the diagnosis of Borderline Personality Disorder as an eligible diagnosis would require a great deal of staff time without additional education and training.

RESPONSE: The Department has determined that this population would be better served by active involvement in the CPR program. Although we agree that additional education and training may be needed to support staff directly serving this group and will work collaboratively with the community in developing this training, the Department has not revised the amendment as requested.

ORDER OF RULEMAKING

By the authority vested in the Missouri Air Conservation Commission under section 643.050, RSMo 2000, the commission amends a rule as follows:

10 CSR 10-5.330 is amended.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed amendment was published in the *Missouri Register* on July 3, 2000 (25 MoReg 1698-1700). Those sections with changes are reprinted here. This proposed amendment becomes effective thirty days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: The Air Pollution Control Program (APCP) only received one comment concerning this proposed amendment. The comment supported the proposed amendment and suggested a minor addition.

COMMENT: Boeing commented in support of the proposed amendment. They also suggested that paragraph (1)(C)1. be deleted to further remove all references to aerospace operations from this rule.

RESPONSE AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGE: The APCP appreciates the support established by this comment. The APCP agrees with the suggested change and paragraph (1)(C)1. has been deleted from section (1). The remaining paragraphs have been renumbered accordingly.

10 CSR 10-5.330 Control of Emissions from Industrial Surface Coating Operations

(1) Applicability.

(C) This rule is not applicable to the surface coating of the following metal parts and products:

1. Automobile refinishing;
2. Customizing top coating of automobiles and trucks, if production is less than thirty-five (35) vehicles per day; and
3. Exterior of marine vessels.

COMMENT: The commenter suggested that the rule should specifically state that the tangible personal property vs. service analysis does not apply to manufactured homes.

RESPONSE: The department disagrees with this comment. The change was not made to the rule because there is a specific rule regarding manufactured homes, which will control the taxability of that situation. No change was made to the proposed rule as a result of this comment.

16 CSR 50-10.030 is adopted.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed rule was published in the *Missouri Register* on July 3, 2000 (25 MoReg 1716-1717). Section (2) is reprinted here. All other sections are adopted as proposed. This proposed rule becomes effective thirty days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: Two comments were received on this proposed rule.

COMMENT: The representative of a county clerk asked for clarification of the application of (2)(B)(iii).

RESPONSE: The match indicated in (2)(B)(iii) applies where the Board determines a matching amount lesser than the full amount allowed by law. The match amount is discretionary and the Board may determine in some years to match less than the full amounts allowed by law. For example, if the Board determined they could only match 30% of contributions in a particular year, and the participant contributed \$1,200, the Board would match \$360, rather than \$600. No changes to the rule were requested or made.

COMMENT: An individual commented that determining how much investment income to apportion to matching contributions based on individual accounts, as provided in (2)(C), may be administratively burdensome and may cause delays.

RESPONSE AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGE: The Board agreed with this comment and clarified the rule by amending subsection (2)(C).

16 CSR 50-10.030 Contributions

(2) Matching Contribution. The Board, in its sole discretion, shall determine if it will make matching contributions for a Plan Year and the aggregate amount of the contribution. Such determination shall be made after the close of the Plan Year for which the contribution is made. Each Qualified Participant (as defined in section (3) below) who makes contributions to the 457 Plan during the Plan Year for which the matching contribution is made shall be eligible to receive an allocation of this matching contribution. Generally the Board shall allocate matching contributions *pro rata* to the Qualified Participant's matching account on the basis of a Qualified Participant's contributions to the 457 Plan. However, the Board shall follow these rules in making this allocation:

(C) If a matching contribution is made for a Plan Year, it shall be allocated to the Participant's matching account as soon as administratively feasible after the close of the Plan Year without regard to any earnings or losses from the close of the Plan Year until the date such allocation is made.

This proposed rule becomes effective thirty days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: Two written comments were received from an individual.

COMMENT: A commenter expressed concern that an administrative burden would result in allocating and distributing a matching contribution, if any, after the close of the plan year in which a deceased or retired participant's account balance has already been distributed.

RESPONSE AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGE: The Board determined section (3) required clarification and amended subsection (3)(B) and added subsection (3)(D) to the rule.

COMMENT: The commenter questioned what action would be taken with regard to the accounts of participants who cannot be located.

RESPONSE AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGE: The Board determined its procedures with regard to the accounts of lost participants should be stated in the rule and amended the rule by adding section (8).

16 CSR 50-10.050 Distribution of Accounts

(3) Commencement of Distributions.

(B) Notwithstanding subsection (3)(A), if the value of a Participant's Account is \$5,000 or less at the time of the Participant's Separation from Service (without respect to any matching contributions which might be allocated following the Participant's Separation from Service), then his or her benefit under the Plan shall be distributed to the Participant in a single sum as soon as administratively feasible following his or her Separation from Service.

(D) In the event a Qualified Participant's Account is distributed upon such Participant's death or retirement and a matching contribution is later allocated to such Qualified Participant's Account for any Plan Year, a subsequent distribution of such Account shall be made as soon as administratively feasible after such matching contribution allocation has been made.

(8) Lost Participants. Notwithstanding any other provision of the Plan, if it is not possible to make payment because the Board cannot locate the Participant after making reasonable efforts to so do, a retroactive payment may be made as soon as administratively feasible after the date on which the Participant is located.

(A) If the Board is unable to locate any person entitled to receive distribution from an Account hereunder, such Account shall be forfeited and used to reduce Employer contributions on the date two years after the date the Board sends by certified mail a notice concerning the benefits to such person at his or her last known address (or determines that there is no last known address).

(B) If an Account is forfeited under this Section and a person otherwise entitled to the Account subsequently files a claim with the Board during any Plan Year, before any allocations for such Plan Year are made, the Account will be restored to the amount which was forfeited without regard to any earnings or losses that would have been allocated. Such restoration shall first be taken out of forfeitures which have not been allocated and if such forfeitures are insufficient to restore such person's account balance, restoration shall be made by an Employer contribution to the Plan.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: One written comment was received from an individual.

COMMENT: The commenter questioned why the maximum deferral amount as stated in the proposed rule shall not exceed the lesser of a) \$7,500 or b) 33 1/3% of the participant's compensation, while information previously provided indicates an employee may contribute the lesser of a) \$8,000 or b) 33 1/3% or 25% gross.

RESPONSE: The full limitation listed in the proposed rule includes a parenthetical statement in (1)(A) that states "(as adjusted for the calendar year to reflect increases in the cost of living in accordance with sections 457(e)(15) and 415(d) of the Code)." This parenthetical indicates that the dollar limitation is subject to change each year in accordance with the Internal Revenue Code, and the dollar limit is now \$8,000. CERF must follow the limitations allowed by the Internal Revenue Service. The reason there are two different percentages in the information previously given employees (33 1/3% and 25%) is the percentage depends on the dollar amount used to calculate the percentage. For example, if total compensation is \$20,000, the 2% contribution to the pension plan would be \$400 and the 0.7% contribution to the 401(a) plan would be \$140, and, therefore, the gross includible compensation would be \$19,460. Up to \$4,865 also could be deferred to the sec-

tion 457 plan (or \$19,460 × 25%). The \$4,865 represents 33 1/3% of the taxable compensation (or \$19,460 - \$4865 = \$14,595). There were no changes to the rule.

(A) If the Board is unable to locate any person entitled to receive distribution from an Account hereunder, such Account shall be forfeited and used to reduce Plan expenses on the date two

years after the date the Board sends by certified mail a notice concerning the benefits to such person at his or her last known address (or determines that there is no last known address).

(B) If an Account is forfeited under this Section and a person otherwise entitled to the Account subsequently files a claim with the Board during any Plan Year, before any allocations for such Plan Year are made, the Account will be restored to the amount which was forfeited without regard to any earnings or losses that would have been allocated. There was a publishing error in subsection (4)(E) of this proposed rule, published in the *Missouri Register* on July 17, 2000 (25 MoReg 1839), which caused the *Missouri Register* text not to match the hard copy filed by the agency. A corrected version of subsection (4)(E) is published here.

(4) Examples.

(E) Taxpayer is a wholesaler of goods. It purchased samples from an out-of-state vendor, which were delivered directly to its Missouri warehouse. The taxpayer at the time of purchase intended that twenty percent (20%) of the samples would go to its Missouri sales force and the other eighty percent (80%) would go to its out-of-state salespersons. All the samples were commingled and were only in Missouri for three (3) months. Because the wholesaler intended to send eighty percent (80%) of the samples out-of-state, the purchase of the eighty percent (80%) is exempt from use tax. However, the wholesaler should pay state and local use tax on any portion of the eighty percent (80%) used in Missouri at the time the samples are removed from the warehouse. Local use tax applies based on the location of the warehouse.

The Secretary of State is required by sections 347.141 and 359.481, RSMo 2000 to publish dissolutions of limited liability companies and limited partnerships. 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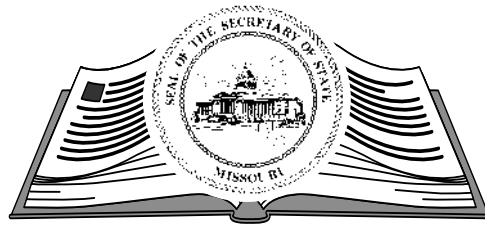
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
