

**T**his section will contain the final text of the rules proposed by agencies. During this period, the agency shall file with the secretary of state the order of rulemaking, either putting the proposed rule into effect, with or without further changes, or withdrawing the proposed rule.

2 CSR 70-40.005 is adopted.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed rule was published in the *Missouri Register* on October 1, 2008 (33 MoReg 1803-1804). Those sections with changes are reprinted here. This proposed rule becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

**SUMMARY OF COMMENTS:** Comments were accepted from October 1 through October 30, 2008. The Missouri Department of Agriculture received written comments from the Treated Wood Council.

**COMMENT:** The Treated Wood Council suggested that the following changes be made to the treated timber definitions: 1) The definition for CCA should include a complete listing of the acceptable uses; 2) The definition for CCA should be re-written to more accurately describe the phase-out of CCA for residential uses; 3) The definition for copper azole should be more detailed and should have any reference to the CCA phase-out removed; 4) The definition for copper naphthenate should include a complete listing of the acceptable uses; and 5) The department should include a definition for ACQ wood preservative.

**RESPONSE AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGE:** 1) Suggestion noted and the definition for CCA will be expanded to include a more thorough listing of acceptable uses; 2) Suggestion noted and definition will be re-worded to accurately reflect the limited uses for CCA; 3) Suggestion noted and definition will be re-worded to remove any negative reference to CCA; 4) Suggestion noted and definition will be expanded to include propiconazole and will contain a more thorough listing of acceptable uses; and 5) The department does not need to define the term ACQ because there is no reference of this product in the rule section.

**2 CSR 70-40.005 Treated Timber Definitions**

(2) Chromated copper arsenate (CCA)—Waterborne wood preservative that is used for the treatment of utility poles, cross arms, pilings, fence posts, and highway structures. Use of this preservative for residential use was eliminated December 31, 2003.

(3) Copper azole—Waterborne wood preservative that was introduced into Missouri in 2004. Primary components of preservative are copper, tebuconazole, and propiconazole. Product is used in the treatment of decking, dimensional lumber, and landscape timbers.

(4) Copper naphthenate—Copper-based wood preservative that has a distinctive dark green color. Product is typically mixed with diesel fuel or P-9 oil and is used in treatment of utility poles, cross arms, landscape timbers, fence posts, rough sawn lumber, and highway structures.

As a matter of public information, the following dates and bag limits shall apply to turkey hunting seasons for 2009. These are based on the formula for season dates set out in subsections (1)(A), (1)(B), and (1)(D) of this rule in the *Code of State Regulations*, and actions of the Conservation Commission on December 18, 2008, to annually establish the season length and bag limit of the spring, fall, and youth hunting seasons.

**Spring Season:** The 2009 spring turkey hunting season will be twenty-one (21) days in length (April 20–May 10, 2009). A person possessing the prescribed turkey hunting permit may take two (2) male turkeys or turkeys with visible beard during the season; provided, only one (1) turkey may be taken the first seven (7) days of the season (April 20 through April 26) and only one (1) turkey may be taken per day from April 27 through May 10. Shooting hours: one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to 1:00 p.m. Central Daylight Savings Time.

**Youth Spring Season Dates:** April 4–5, 2009. A youth possessing the prescribed youth turkey hunting permit and who is at least six (6) but not older than fifteen (15) years of age may take one (1) male turkey or turkey with visible beard. Shooting hours: one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to sunset, Central Daylight Savings Time.

**Fall Season:** The 2009 fall turkey hunting season will be thirty-one (31) days in length (October 1–October 31, 2009). Two turkeys of either sex may be taken during the season. Shooting hours: one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to sunset, Central Daylight Savings Time.

**Background**

The individuals listed in this notice have recently filed applications requesting MoDOT to issue SPE Certificates to exempt them from the physical qualification requirements relating to vision in 49 CFR 391.41(b)(10), or to diabetes in 49 CFR 391.41(b)(3), which otherwise apply to drivers of CMVs in Missouri intrastate commerce.

Under section 622.555, RSMo Supp. 2007, MoDOT may issue a Skill Performance Evaluation Certificate, for not more than a two (2)-year period, if it finds that the applicant has the ability, while operating CMVs, to maintain a level of safety that is equivalent to or greater than the driver qualification standards of 49 CFR 391.41. Upon application, MoDOT may renew an exemption upon expiration.

Accordingly, the agency will evaluate the qualifications of each applicant to determine whether issuing an SPE Certificate will comply with the statutory requirements and will achieve the required level of

safety. If granted, the SPE Certificate is only applicable to intrastate transportation wholly within Missouri.

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
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
