Wolfner Talking Book and Braille Library Webinar

The State Library will present a webinar on Wolfner Talking Book and Braille Library on October 16, 2014, at 10 a.m. Registration is required and may be completed [online](#).

This session describes the statewide library service for Missourians with visual or physical disabilities. Answers to frequently asked questions will be addressed, like who qualifies for the service, how to start the service, what equipment is loaned, the extent of the collection and the many convenient ways the collection can be accessed. The webinar will also discuss some of the new technologies like BARD (the Braille and Audio Download site) and the BARD mobile app for iOS devices. Wolfner patrons enjoy the added value of an assigned reader advisor, recommended reading lists and locally produced audiobooks.

Input Needed for Mental Health First Aid Training Locations and Schedule

It can be difficult to know how to react if someone in the library is experiencing a mental health crisis. What should be said or done? Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) training can equip anyone with the tools necessary to assist someone during a mental health crisis. It is not training to make a diagnosis, but rather what to say or do, and how to get the help necessary for someone who is in a crisis situation.

The Missouri Department of Mental Health's Librarian 411 Project will offer four **free** MHFA trainings for Missouri library staff in fall 2014 and spring 2015. To help determine where and when
