To the Honorable the Senate and House of
Representatives of the State of Mississippi
Your Petitioner Thomas H. Loyd of the
County of Ray would respectfully represent that
in the month of October in the year of our Lord
1838 he was a regular Militiaman in the company
of Mounted Militia under the command of Capt
Samuel Bogart of said County, that said Militia
were employed in the Service of the State in the
Suppression of the Mormon distasteful wars, and
that in the battle which occurred on the 35th day
of said month of October between said Militia
and the Mormons your petitioner received
so many and such serious wounds from the
hands of the enemy as to be thereby disabled
from your effective manual labor, and that
there is now no reasonable hope that such dis-
ability will or can be remedied. Your petitioner
further represents that he is near twenty five
years of age, that he is poor and that he has a
family which as well as himself, depends upon
his labor for support. Your petitioner there-
fore prays that an act may be passed for his benefit
granting him a pension during his life ordering
the continuance of his disability, and your
petitioner will pray, &c.
